





## Who can participate?

## What do I need?


 <b>Catalans over 16</b>	A valid DNI or NIE displaying residency in Catalonia (participation takes place in the location of residency displayed on DNI or NIE)
 <b>National citizens of European Union Member States</b>	A national identification document or a valid passport with a EU Citizens Register certificate displaying the residency in Catalonia
 <b>Non-EU nationals</b>	A valid passport and Foreigner ID card (TIE) stating the address of residence in Catalonia
 <b>Catalans residing abroad</b>	A national identity document (DNI or NIE) displaying the residency in Catalonia or either a national identity document or passport with a registration certificate by the Register of Catalans Living Abroad or by the Register of Spaniards Living Abroad

## Where can I participate?


To know your assigned locality to participate, visit [www.participa2014.cat](http://www.participa2014.cat) or call **012**. From the address listed on your national identity document you will be able to find out where exactly you can participate on November 9<sup>th</sup>.



**Designated locations on November 9<sup>th</sup> from 9am until 8pm**



If you are a Catalan living abroad, there are 19 locations situated around the world. Or, if you want to participate in Catalonia, you can do so at the Palau Robert




At the polling station and before participation takes place you will have to register your name on a numbered list to avoid duplications




The period of deliberation will be from October 30<sup>th</sup> until November 8<sup>th</sup>
