Youth Guarantee: the Government's new approach to tackle unemployment

The Government of Catalonia approves its youth employment programme, *Garantia Juvenil* (Youth Guarantee) 2014-2020 as well as this year's action plan to tackle unemployment among young persons.

The Youth Employment Initiative is a programme launched by the European Commission to address Europe's high unemployment rate among youths and consists of a €6bn budget distributed among the EU Member States.

€241m has been made available to Catalonia until 2020.

* Through joint funding from the Government of Catalonia and the European Social Fund.

Youth Guarantee is a step forward in Catalonia's youth employment policies.

Aside from offering suitable training for opportunities in the job market, it brings young people closer to their first work experience which helps them develop necessary skills to start a professional career in the future.

AIMED AT

All young persons between 16 and 24 who are neither working nor studying.

Disabled persons under the age of 30 with a degree of invalidity over 33%.

The Generalitat offers a Portfolio of Services and Programmes to access employment, training or internships lasting up to 4 months So far,

8,300 Catalan youths between 16 and 24,

who are neither working nor studying, have registered to the Youth Guarantee programme. Nearly 5,000 have already received training services or job opportunities.
