The Plan intends to alter the unequal balance of power across all areas to reduce inequalities, generate change and empower women

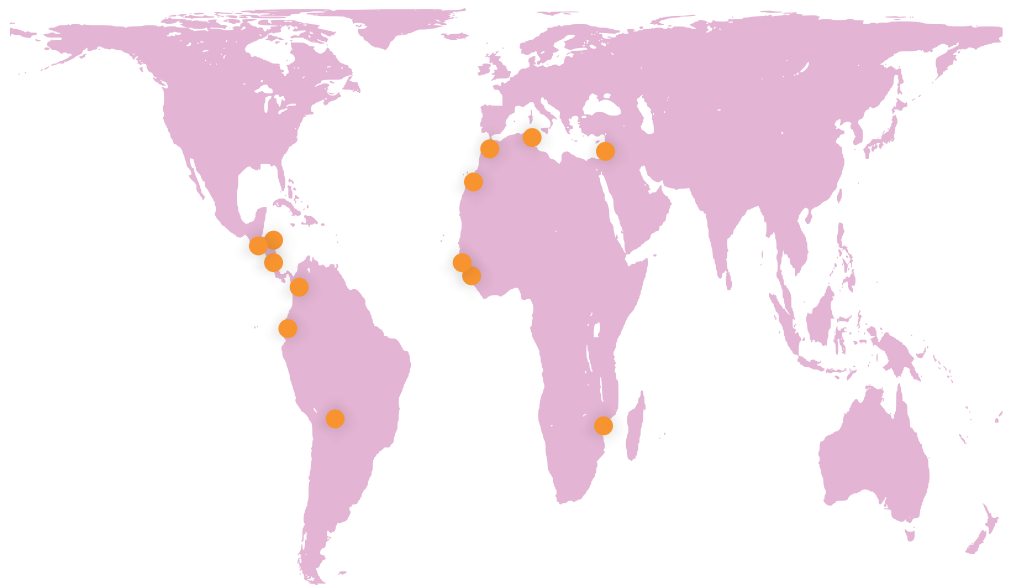
