## At 1pm, voter turnout in Catalonia was 35.12%

**This percentage is 5.7 points higher than the voter turnout registered in the 2012 parliamentary elections**

The Minister for Governance and Institutional Relations, Meritxell Borràs, held a press conference shortly after the first provisional voter turnout results for the elections to the Parliament of Catalonia were known.

Borràs noted that, at 1pm, the average voter turnout in the four provincial constituencies was 35.12%. 5.7 points higher than the 29.43% turnout registered at the same time during the 2012 elections to the Parliament of Catalonia.

### By demarcation

Voter turnout in all four constituencies registered a higher percentage than in the parliamentary elections of 2012. The constituency with the highest turnout is Girona, currently reaching 38.47%.
