In March 2014, the Parliament of Catalonia approved Resolution 577/X, which set up a series of measures to be implemented by the Catalan Government and its various ministries. Most of these agreements have already been fulfilled

Key measures adopted

- Measures aimed at children and youths from vulnerable families
- 100% grants for school meals subsidized for students at social risk
- Maintain universal public healthcare
- New food distribution programme
- Fight against energy poverty
- Actions to **improve employment** opportunities for people with difficulties entering the job market
- Make minimum insertion income a subjective right
- Broaden welfare benefits to cover **housing and property maintenance**
- Support entities in developing actions to fight against poverty
