160,000

asylum seekers have been granted protection status and will be relocated across the EU over the next two years

5,000

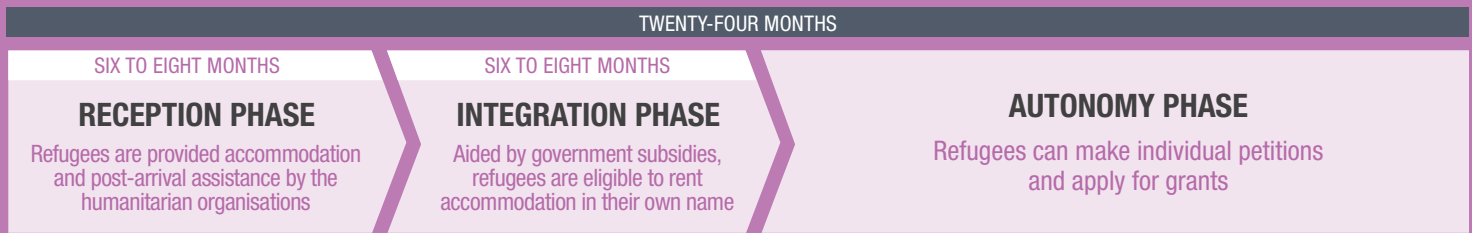
could arrive in Catalonia (17,000 have been allocated to the Spanish State)



The State has appointed 3 humanitarian organisations (**Red Cross, ACCEM and CCAR**) to take part in refugee reception activities

€ 6,000 /year

is what the State will receive for every refugee it hosts for a period of 24 months



The State's ineffectiveness and disloyalty

What is happening?

- ↓ The State has received only 18 refugees out the 17,000 that were initially allocated to Spain.
- ↓ The State is not disclosing any information to the Generalitat.
- ↓ There is an excess of bureaucratization.
- ↓ The capacity of the Generalitat and local government to support the integration of refugees is being marginalised.
- ↓ The current system does not encourage cooperation between social entities.

What do we want?

- ↑ To share information regarding the refugees arriving to Catalonia.
- ↑ To have an active role in the process and offer support to the humanitarian organizations involved .
- ↑ To cooperate with local governments in order to strengthen services and effectively solve problems of coexistence.
- ↑ To establish co-financing protocols with the State on funds granted by the EU.
