




The Catalan Government reaffirms its commitment to the United Nations
with a national initiative to implement the 2030 Agenda in Catalonia

What is the 2030 Agenda?

The 2030 Agenda is a global plan of action for sustainable development. It was unanimously approved on September 25th, 2015, through adoption of Resolution 70/1 "Transforming our world: the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development" by the United Nations General Assembly. **The Agenda's objective is to stimulate international action for the next fifteen years in five areas of critical importance for humanity and the planet: People, Planet, Prosperity, Peace and Partnership.**

 The 2030 Agenda is based on the 17 Sustainable Development Goals

How will the 2030 Agenda be implemented in Catalonia?

 For the effective implementation of the 2030 Agenda in Catalonia an initial internal study will be conducted whereby the departments of the Generalitat will assign the 17 Sustainable Development Goals to the relevant Catalan laws and plans that are either currently in effect, programmed or being prepared.

Once the internal study has been conducted, a participative process will be open to all relevant actors in Catalonia to elaborate a National Plan with the maximum consensus possible and ensure the 2030 Agenda is fulfilled.

Global objectives, local commitments

Catalonia already has specific initiatives in place for 6 of the 17 SDGs in the 2030 Agenda:

END POVERTY



With the aim of reducing inequalities and providing security for all, the Government intends to secure a guaranteed minimum income by the end of 2017 for all Catalans who don't have access to other national or state subsidies

GENDER EQUALITY



Through its research and evaluation, the Gender Equality of Observatory of Catalonia has become an important tool towards achieving effective equality between men and women

ZERO HUNGER



Catalonia is planning normative projects on climate change and the protection and management of agricultural land, while working intensively to reduce waste and ensure food security

INDUSTRY, INNOVATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE



The National Pact for Industry and the Strategy to Encourage a Green Economy are fundamental for the Catalan industry's transition to a model where sustainability is a key factor for national competitiveness

GOOD HEALTH AND WELL-BEING



In June 2017, the Parliament of Catalonia passed a law guaranteeing universal access to healthcare for anyone living in the country with the right to all the benefits made available by the Catalan Health Service

MARINE ECOSYSTEMS



The Government is also working on an action plan for marine life in Catalonia and has established a new model of governance for the country's coasts
