

# Report on the incidents that took place from the 1st to the 4th of October 2017

Patients receiving care on election day and the days following as a result of charges by the Spanish police forces

On the day of the election held on the 1st of October 2017, 991 people were seen and diagnosed by professionals of the Medical Emergencies System (SEM), Primary Care Centres (CAP), Continuous Care Units (PAC), Emergency Primary Care Centres (CUAP) and hospitals as a result of charges by Spanish police forces. Of these, 214 were seen by the SEM and 777 were visited at medical clinics: 38 hospitals, 40 CAPs and PACs and 14 CUAPs.

Between the 2nd and 4th of October 2017, a further 75 people were seen at medical clinics.

Therefore, the number of people seen in connection with the aforementioned police charges between the 1st and 4th of October totalled 1,066 people.

- One case of acute myocardial infarction (Vall d'Hebron University Hospital).
- One case of fracture of orbital floor and upper right jaw with eyeball involvement (Santa Creu i Sant Pau Hospital).
- One case of abdominal and head trauma with hypertensive crisis (Hospital Plato).
- One case of head trauma with loss of consciousness (Santa Caterina Hospital).
- One case of trauma to the right shoulder and right trapezius muscle trauma (Santa Creu i Sant Pau Hospital).
