To extend the impact of the MWC to other places around Catalonia, including Girona, Lleida, Reus, Igualada and Ribera d'Ebre

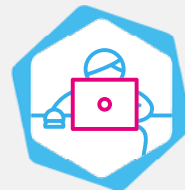

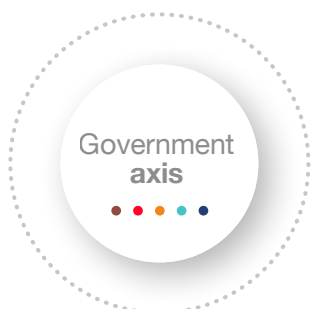
