## WHAT HAVE WE DONE?

### Law 16/2017

We adopted a pioneering law to combat climate change with the aim of **reducing greenhouse gas emissions** (GHG) and catalysing the **transition to a carbon-neutral economy**

↘ -23% GHG 2005-2017    ↘ -40% 2030

### We declared a climate emergency

We will carry out actions related to legislation, governance, knowledge generation, sensitisation and awareness-raising, climate justice, giving impetus to the energy transition and mitigation, and increasing adaptive capacity

### Decree-law on urgent measures to tackle the climate emergency and promote renewable energies



- ↘ Eliminates administrative barriers to the deployment of wind and solar power in Catalonia
- ↘ Introduces a streamlined approval procedure
- ↘ Sets the goal of achieving carbon neutrality by 2050

### Catalan summit on the climate emergency (17 January 2020)

The aim is to bring people together to agree a short- and medium-term road map for climate change mitigation and adaptation policy, with commitments from the government and from social and economic actors

### Catalan Strategy for a Green and Circular Economy

We're fostering a system change towards **a circular economy in which waste is recovered and reintroduced into the production chain** – a shift from seeing waste as something to throw away to viewing it as a resource
