3/3  **PRE-ALERT****Activation of the PROCICAT civil protection plan**

Confirmation of first cases in CATALUNYA

11/3  **ALERT****Decision SLT/704/2020**

Suspension of gatherings of over 1000 people; limit of 1/3 of capacity for smaller gatherings
Suspension of public sports events

12/3  **EMERGENCY 1****Decision INT/718/2020**

Closure of schools and universities
Restrictions on people leaving Igualada, Òdena, Santa Margarida de Montbui and Vilanova del Camí

The Ministry of Health has launched the **StopCovid19Cat** app to monitor infected individuals, gather information on the evolution of the pandemic, and optimise decision-making
