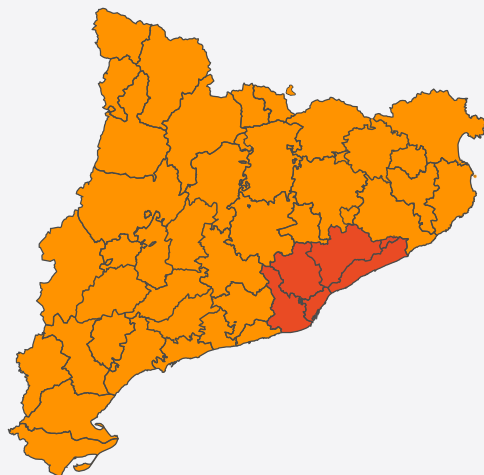




From Monday, 18 May, lockdown restrictions are gradually being eased in Catalonia by health region. Two broad zones have been defined.

Regions in Phase 1

- Health regions of Girona, Lleida, Central Catalonia, Camp de Tarragona and Terres de l'Ebre, as well as Alt Penedès and El Garraf



Regions in Advanced Phase 0

- Barcelona
- Metropolitan Area
- Baix Montseny

Phase 1: Measures coming into effect

- Occupancy of up to 30% of capacity for **commercial establishments up to 400 m²**.
- Opening of **libraries** for lending and return of material and consultation only.
- Vehicle inspection centres, car dealerships, garden centres, nurseries and gaming centres**, of any size may open. Appointments required.
- Schools, universities and university laboratories** may open for maintenance and administrative tasks. People must be kept 2 m apart. Disinfection measures required.
- Gatherings and meetings** of up to 10 people.
- Gatherings in **places of worship**. Up to 1/3 of capacity.
- Pick-up of goods at business premises and home delivery**. Measures to avoid crowding inside premises and at entrances.
- High-performance athlete** may train at centres close to their homes, within the same health region. Access and training schedules will be set. Limit of 30% of capacity with safety measures and disinfection.
- Opening of **museums, auditoriums, theatres and cinemas**. Limit of 30% of capacity.
- Shared use of private vehicles** for people living in the same home. Circulation at any time of day; only within the same health region.
- Outdoor terraces may open**. Up to 50% of tables occupied; at least 2 m between tables and groups; maximum of 10 people seated together. Food and beverages may not be consumed inside premises.
- Training for professional leagues**. Physical and tactical training for groups of up to 10. Distancing must be maintained. Number of participants may not exceed 30% of capacity for athletes.
- Funeral parlours** may open with up to 15 people in outdoor spaces and up to 10 in enclosed spaces.
- Social service centres and services** must be open and available to provide face-to-face attention to clients when necessary.
- Reopening of hotels and tourist accommodation**. Identification of access areas and restrictions. Hygiene and safety measures; 2 m distance between guests and staff.
- Telework** will continue to be encouraged whenever possible.

TIME SLOTS FOR GOING OUTDOORS
